**ST ANDREWS AT "THE SPRINGS"**

**On June 12, the rezoning for the project was approved** in principle by City of Port Moody. Further design and legal work needs to be completed before the new zoning can be enacted by Council. This work is underway and **final Council approval of the new zoning is expected in September**. The Development Permit can then be issued as well.

A Building Permit application is being submitted in June. After the project is tendered to the construction market in August and a firm construction price is determined, the project can seek Final

Project Approval from BC Housing. After all of the City of Port Moody approvals are in place and the project has BC Housing Final Approval, construction can begin. This is expected to occur in October. The public hearing on June 12 was a major project milestone. That said, there is still quite a bit of work to do before construction can start. We will get there and the ground-breaking ceremony will be wonderful!!
