## ***Transformation Update***

The Transformation Steering Group met on May 29 with **Catalyst Community Developments Society** and a mechanical engineer to discuss energy efficient approaches to the mechanical systems in our new building. We also discussed progress with our rezoning application to the City. An initial response has come back to us, with specific questions and recommendations. Catalyst is working on these, and will update us soon. It's likely that our timeline will be somewhat slower than expected. We will update the congregation as soon as we know anything definitely. Other work underway is the **search for worship and office space during the construction phase**. We are still looking for another helper to work with Julie Lebrun and Julie Asselstine on this. The TSG is working on **forming a not-for-profit society** to administer the housing portion of the project. As the project accelerates, the TSG will keep you updated.
